
1. First Row(1st part)

4 triangle parts first



 Put the petal on the triangleshaped surface: the base of petal meets on the horizontal wire in the triangle.



 Please do the same on the rest of the triangle-shaped surface.



1. First Row(2nd part)

4 rectangular parts



 Put the petal on the rectangular side, slightly below the wire frame.



 Please do the same on the rest of the rectangular-shaped surface.



2. Second Row






Place the petal on a vertical wire frame at half way between two horizontal wire frames, in-between first-row petals. (8 petals in total)

From the second row, petals will be placed in-between 2 petals in the previous row



3. Third Row





Put the petal in the middle of the rectangular surface, aligning its bottom to the horizontal wire frame.

After finishing 3rd row, put the whole lantern upside down



4. Fourth Row






On each vertical wire , place the petal half way down. (8 petals in total)

Since the is narrower, the petals might be overlapped.



5. Fifth Row

4 corners first



Base of the petal stop on the edge of the wire.

4 squares second



Base of the petal stop on the wire.



6. Leaves (1st part)

4 corners first



Place the leaf over the wire.





4 corners finished.

Hold with a finger on the edge of the wire and tuck the leaf in with other finger



6. Leaves (2nd part)

Last 4 leaves:

Flip 4 leaves, then apply the glue





Flip the leaf and place it over the wire and tuck in with fingers.

Put the finger inside wire to check up all the leaves attached inside.





Important!





Place the lantern upside down until it is completely dried.

If you would like to hang the lantern, you can later take out the wire inside from the top of the lantern.
